Please reach out to us to ask questions about any of these roles described on the attached sheet as our teachers are very flexible and so are we. We do not want anyone to feel excluded from the classroom if they wish to volunteer. We are happy to chat with you to discuss time commitments, greater detail of these positions and will work with you. Keep in mind, the children also love to see our parents' (and grandparents) special talents and interests as well. If you can juggle, play the guitar or have a fun job you would like to talk to the kids about, please let us know!

We will be available to speak to you in person about volunteering at our back-to-school events, however, please feel free to email us in the meantime with any questions. We look forward to hearing from you and seeing you in the classroom.

<u>Classroom Opportunities</u> - These are volunteer opportunities for parents who would like to spend time in the classroom or make a direct contribution to the classroom by supporting the teachers from home.

Room Parent – Plan and organize class holiday and year-end parties. Plan a student made class project to give the teachers at holiday time and the end of the year. Work with other room parents and Parent Volunteer Chair to plan Teacher Appreciation Week.

Story Reader – Read a story, do a finger play or other literary activity in the classroom. Choose a story or activity involving reading and/or writing skills that will enhance children's learning experience in the classroom. It would be great if the story/activity has a connection to the class's current project or topic of study.

Games & Recreation Parent – Work with the children to teach them a game or lead them in an activity. Coordinate with the teachers concerning appropriate space and equipment needed for the game or activity. Incorporate an understanding of the rules of sportsmanship in the process.

Art Project Parent - Work with the teachers to create and/or implement an art project. Come into the classroom to work on an art project from set up to clean up. Assist the teachers to appropriately display the project once completed.

Health & Wellness Committee – Visit the classroom approximately once a month to provide mini lessons about physical wellness. Lessons will involve providing information about the health benefits of eating nutritious foods, engaging in fun fitness activities with the kids (yoga and more) as well as games and lessons that get our children moving and learning about the importance of growing up healthy!

Teacher's Helper – Parents on this list are available for teachers to call upon when they need help and/or resources for special projects. Parents may be called upon to help with in class tasks such as posting bulletin boards, taking dictation from students, printing photos or other such tasks. Parents may also be called on to help prepare materials at home involving cutting, gluing, or putting things together. Finally, parents may be called upon to do research about a topic or gather books or other such resources that may be needed for an upcoming project.

<u>Parent Board Committee Opportunities</u> - These are volunteer opportunities for parents who would like to participate in helping out with the work of the Kinderhaven Parent Board.
